JANUARY 2014

 White Wednesday. Octave Day of Nativity of the Lord. SOLEMNITY OF MARY, THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD.

LH of the solemnity. — Office pr. — At Middle Hour proper antiphons and supplementary pss.

MASS of the solemnity, Gloria, Creed, with Preface of BVM I (... et te in maternitate / on the Solemnity of the Motherhood ...) and inserts of Christmas for the Eucharistic Prayer.

Other celebrations are not permitted, not even funeral Masses.

Second VESPERS of solemnity.

Weekdays of the Christmas Time:

- 1. On weekdays of Christmas Time from 2 January onwards on which an optional memorial is observed, it is possible to choose either the Office and Mass of the weekday, or the Office and Mass of the Saint who is inscribed for that day in the calendar or in the Martyrology (IH, 244; IM, 355 b).
- 2. Only when some genuine need or pastoral advantage requires it, may an appropriate Mass for various needs and intentions or a votive Mass be celebrated. (IM, 376).

Daily Masses for the Dead are not permitted (IM, 381).

CHRISTMAS TIME

3. In the weekday Office, the Invitatory antiphon, the Hymns for the Office of Readings, for Lauds and for Vespers, and the antiphon at the Middle Hour are taken from those prescribed for the season, before or after the Epiphany as the case may be.

Before Lent

The weeks of Ordinary Time celebrate no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ. Instead, especially on the last Sundays, celebration is made of the mystery of Christ in all its fullness (LY 43).

The weekday lectionary for Mass is taken from Year II.

In votive Masses, and in Saturday Masses of Our Lady, vestments may be of the customary proper colour, or of the colour of the day or of the season (IM, 347).
