NATIONAL COUNCIL OF VINCENTIAN PROVINCES

Visitors of the US Provinces of the Vincentians and the delegates from the Provinces to the General Assembly in Rome held their November meeting in St. Louis, MO. They established the National Council of Vincentian Provinces (NCVP) with the following mandate: "The NCVP serves the Provinces of the Congregation of the Mission in the USA as they renew themselves in the Vincentian charism."

NCVP will be composed of seven members: - Three Visitors and four delegates from the provinces. There will be three permanent standing committees: Lifestyle: Spiritual & Community, Prophetic

Ministries, Vocations & Initial Formation. All committees might invite other CMs, Vincentian Family Members, and other collaborators to serve on the committees.
